At Saints Netball Club, providing safe, welcoming, and joyful experiences for every child and family is at the heart of everything we do. We believe that every child has the right to feel safe, supported, and protected, everywhere, and always.

To keep children safe, we commit to:

- Implementing the 10 Child Safe Standards
- Providing a safe and supportive environment for all children
- Ensuring that children are not exposed to any form of harmful conduct or abuse
- Empowering children to participate in decisions that affect them and share their concerns
- Ensuring children know who to approach if they feel unsafe or have any child safety concerns

As a child safe organisation, we commit to:

- Educating everyone involved in our organisation about what it means to be a child safe organisation, so that we can prevent, detect and effectively respond to child abuse
- Ensuring everyone involved in our organisation knows how to appropriately respond to breaches of our Child Safe Code of Conduct
- Welcoming feedback to continuously improve our child safe policies, procedures and practices
- Ensuring that when family and community members interact with our Club, they are aware that child safety is everyone's responsibility, and that their behaviour aligns with our child safe practices
- Building a culturally safe space that honours the diverse backgrounds, experiences, and identities of the families we serve
- Actively listening to children and families and acting on what we hear
